Surface Preparation

Ensure the substrate to be treated is sound and free from any surface contaminant (e.g. wax, grease, polish etc).

Application Method

Brush, spray, lint free cloth.
Ensure products are thoroughly shaken before use. Apply using brush, cloth or spray.
If applying by brush apply one thin coat. Whilst the coat is wet remove surplus with a coarse cloth. A second application may be applied if there is still suction in the wood.

Recommended Spreading Rate

Up to 30m²/l depending on absorbency of the wood.

Thinning

Not required

Drying Time

Touch dry in 1-3 hours. Re-coat time will depend on the absorbency of the wood and drying conditions. Always check on small area prior to coating the whole area.

Cleaning

Clean application equipment or spills with white spirit or Blackfriar Brush Cleaner.

Limitations

NB. For new wood only.

Not recommended for use on previously coated surfaces even if stripped back to bare wood.

If using a wax polish on top of Blackfriar Wood Dye, seal first with a coat of Blackfriar White French Polish.
